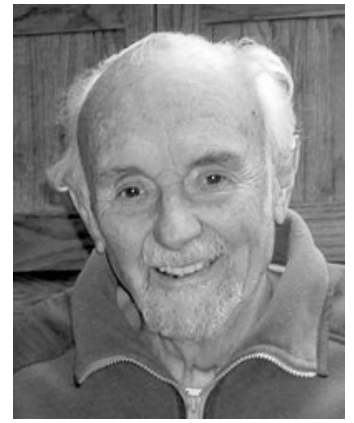




THE GRANT W. SHARPE AWARD
