### A. Overview:

Provide a one-page summary describing your project. Description should include how the project fits into your park or organization's mission, how it meets the goals of NAI/Havasi Foundation and why Region 9 should fund your project.

### B. Mini-Grant Criteria:

- Applicant must be a member of NAI Region 9
- Project must address/involve families, children or teenagers
- Project must involve the natural environment and connect to the Havasi Foundation website in some way
- Project must demonstrate how you will recognize the Havasi Foundation (<http://havasiwf.org/>) & NAI within your project implementation

### C. Additional information:

- At the end of the project, applicants must submit final report to NAI Region 9, including photos, descriptions, etc. to be submitted to the Havasi Foundation
- Mini grant applications are due August 27, 2010; applications will be reviewed in September and grants awarded in October.
